

**Prairie Business Park Now Underway**

The Village Board recently approved the Prairie Business Park at the southwest corner of Higgins and Tyrrell Roads. The new development by Interstate Partners will include 40+ acres for 4-5 large industrial buildings and roughly 7 acres for future commercial development along Higgins Road. The first phase started with the 200,000 square foot industrial building now underway, which will be ready for businesses to move into this July. 
