

Village of Gilberts Meeting Information

Gilberts Village Board:

By definition, a municipality is “a political unit, such as a city, town, or village, incorporated (by the state) for local self-government or a body of officials appointed to manage the affairs of a local political unit.” The Village Board is comprised of those individuals elected to manage the affairs of the Village of Gilberts. The Village Board meets the first and third Tuesday of each month. Meetings are held in the Board Room located at 87 Galligan Rd. Gilberts, IL and begin at 7p.m.

Committee of the Whole:

The Committee of the Whole is the entire membership of a legislative body, sitting in a deliberative rather than a legislative capacity, for informal debate and preliminary consideration of matters awaiting legislative action. The Committee of the Whole meets the second Tuesday of each month. Meetings are held in the Board Room located at 87 Galligan Rd. Gilberts, IL and begin at 7p.m.

Plan Commission:

The Plan Commission is delegated to propose plans for future activities and developments of the community. The Village of Gilberts Plan Commission meets on an as needed basis. Meetings are held in the Board Room located at 87 Galligan Rd. Gilberts, IL and begin at 7p.m.

Zoning Board of Appeals:

The Zoning Board of Appeals must be formed when a local legislature adopts its zoning law. The essential function of the zoning board of appeals is to grant variances. In this capacity it protects landowners from the unfair application of the laws in particular circumstances. The zoning board of appeals also hears appeals from the decisions of the zoning enforcement officer or building inspector when interpretations of the zoning ordinance are involved. The Village of Gilberts Zoning Board of Appeals meets on an as needed basis. Meetings are held in the Board Room located at 87 Galligan Rd. Gilberts, IL and begin at 7p.m.

Police Pension Fund:

In each Illinois municipality, as defined in Section 3-103, the city council or the board of trustees, as the case may be, shall establish and administer a police pension fund, as prescribed in this Article, for the benefit of its police officers and of their surviving spouses, children, and certain other dependents. The Village of Gilberts Police Pension Fund meets on a quarterly basis, the first Wednesday of the month, typically February, May, August and September. Meetings begin at 6 p.m. and are held in the Training Room of the Gilberts Police Department, 86 Railroad St. Gilberts IL.

Police Commission:

The Board of Fire and Police Commissioners have the authority to make original appointments to the Police and Fire Departments, promotions to ranks, and to discipline members of the police department and fire department in accordance with the rules, regulations and the ordinances of the Village of Gilberts. The Village of Gilberts Police Commission meets on an as needed basis. Meetings begin at 6 p.m. and are held in the Training Room of the Gilberts Police Department, 86 Railroad St. Gilberts IL.
