VILLAGE OF GILBERTS

ORDINANCE 10-2024

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2 OF TITLE 3 OF THE VILLAGE CODE REGARDING THE NUMBER OF CLASS OS LIQUOR LICENSES

WHEREAS, the Village is authorized by the Illinois Liquor Control Act, 235 ILCS 5/1 *et seq.* to license and regulate the sale of alcoholic beverages in the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village has established local liquor license regulations in Chapter 2 of Title 3 of the Gilberts Village Code; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board of Trustees desires to amend the Village Code to increase the number of available Class OS liquor licenses by one; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board of Trustees finds it to be in the best interests of the Village and its residents to amend the Village Code regarding the number of Class OS as set forth in this Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Village Board of the Village of Gilberts, Kane County, Illinois pursuant to its non-home rule powers, as follows:

SECTION 1. RECITALS The recitals set forth above are incorporated into Section 1 as set forth herein.

Section 3-2-9 "Number of Licenses" of Chapter 2 "Liquor Control" of Title 3 of the Gilberts Village Code shall hereby be amended to read as follows (deletions in strikethrough, additions in bold and underline):

"3-2-9. Number of licenses.

A. The Liquor Commissioner shall be authorized to issue the following number of licenses to be outstanding at any one time:

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY. In the event that any section, clause, provision, or part of this Ordinance shall be found and determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid pars shall remain in full force and effect. If any part of this Ordinance is found to be invalid in any one or more of its several applications, all valid applications shall remain in effect.

SECTION 4. REPEAL AND SAVINGS CLAUSE. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however that nothing in this Ordinance shall affect any rights, actions, or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Gilberts prior to the effective date of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall only be effective upon the passage, approval, and publication in the manner required by law.
